

MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT
ON ACADEMIC CO-OPERATION
BETWEEN
RENMIN UNIVERSITY OF CHINA
(PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF CHINA)
AND
L.N. GUMILYOV EURASIAN NATIONAL UNIVERSITY
(REPUBLIC OF KAZAKHSTAN)

Renmin University of China and the **Republican State Enterprise «L.N. Gumilyov Eurasian National University»** have concluded this Memorandum of Agreement in recognition of the mutual benefits accruing to their academic communities from the establishment of strong international links.

Article 1

The purpose of this Memorandum is to promote friendly relations through the development of academic collaboration between the two universities.

Article 2

The two universities agree to promote and develop their co-operation by the following means:

- Facilitating admission of staff and students
- Exploring the possibility of staff and student exchanges
- Exploring the possibility of joint cooperative research projects
- The exchange of information and academic publications
- Exploring the possibility of joint applications for scholarships through educational programs that exist in both universities
- Such other ways as may be mutually acceptable

Article 3

Members of staff of both universities will be encouraged to consult with each other

and to develop specific plans for collaboration in any of the ways mentioned in Article 3 above.

Article 4

Recognizing that the implementation of any form of academic collaboration depends on the availability of financial support both universities shall use their best endeavors to identify and gain access to suitable sources of funding to support the activities proposed in the Memorandum.

Article 5

This Memorandum will become effective from the date when representatives of both universities shall have affixed their signatures to it, and shall be valid for an initial period of 5 (five) years and automatically prolonged for the next 5 (five) years unless it is terminated by one of the universities upon prior notice to the other in writing not later than 6 (six) months before the termination date.

Article 6

The Memorandum may be revised or modified within its period of validity by mutual consent. It may also be terminated within that period by either party giving not less than three months written notice of the intention to terminate to the other party.


