

**MEMORANDUM
OF MUTUAL INTENT
between**

Tokai University
(Japan)
and
The L.N. Gumilyov Eurasian National University
(The Republic of Kazakhstan)

In accordance with a mutual objective to promote further cooperation in the field of exchange students and academic staff, on behalf of the L.N. Gumilyov of Eurasian National University rector Abdraimov Bakhitzhan Zharylkasymovich, and on behalf of Tokai University chancellor Jiro Takano hereinafter referred to as the "Parties", separately "Party", signed the memorandum on following :

Article 1

The purpose of the present Memorandum is to develop international cooperation in the fields of education, research and exchanges of professors and students. This cooperation includes activities in educational and scientific fields and in other areas which can be interesting for Parties.

Article 2

For realization of the purpose of the present Memorandum, Parties cooperate in following spheres:

- 2.1 exchange of academic staff and researchers;
- 2.2 establishment of scientific research, mutual publication of academic staff and researchers' scientific results;
- 2.3 exchange of students, master students and PhD;
- 2.4 promotion of exchange of reference data, publications, and academic information and literature;
- 2.5 organization of delegation's visits to participate in conferences and etc.

Article 3

To realize the goals of this present Memorandum Parties undertake:

- 3.1 to give the necessary information for the organization and perfection of activities within the framework of the present Memorandum
- 3.2 to provide appropriate execution of the present Memorandum.

Article 4

4.1 The Parties will promote and facilitate the exchange of students. The detailed conditions governing such student exchanges will be set forth in a separate addendum.



Article 5

5.1 Researchers of each Party pay fees by their own for courses in which they intend to take part.

Article 6

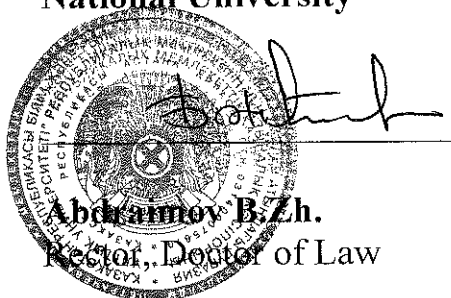
6.1 The present Memorandum enters into force on signature and it is valid within the period of 3 years, with the subsequent prolongation each time for the same terms if it is the absence of objections.

6.2 Party separately may terminate the Memorandum by officially notifying the other Party in writing six months before the date of discontinuance of the Memorandum.

6.3 All appendixes, amendments and addendum are integral part of the present Memorandum and are valid in case they are signed by authorized representatives of Parties.

6.4 This Memorandum is made in two copies in English and Russian languages for each Party, which have equal legal power.
