

Memorandum of Cooperation

10th October, 2016

RSE «Eurasian National University named after L.N. Gumilyov», represented by the Rector Sydykov E.B., acting under the Charter, and **Austrian Society of Engineers and Architects (ÖIAV)** represented by the President Prof. Heinz Brandl,

referred to hereinafter individually the "Party" and together the "Parties"

- Recognizing the importance of international cooperation,
- To develop research and other mutually beneficial cooperation in the interests of both Parties,
- Guided by the principles of equality, mutual respect, mutual interest and benefit,
- Expressing the desire to co-operate on a long term basis,

The parties have entered into this Memorandum as follows:

Article 1

Parties within the limits of authority, and taking into account mutual interests, the main focus of joint cooperation determine the development of innovative entrepreneurship and innovative research in the field of education, science and industry.

This Memorandum defines the general relations between the Parties on the implementation of joint activities, programs and projects.

In furtherance of this Memorandum, is expected to expand and deepen the scope and framework of cooperation, the Parties shall develop and implement specific measures, programs and projects on the basis of certain prepared and signed agreements.

Article 2

The parties will focus their efforts on developing and promoting innovative structure elements.

Each event, program or project will be implemented on the basis of separate agreements between the parties and other organizations, is to develop the provisions of this Memorandum, which define in detail the purpose of the activities and obligations of the Parties budget.

Article 3

Parties nominate executors responsible for the execution of the terms of this Memorandum, as shall notify each other.

When they replaced the Parties shall promptly notify each other.

Article 4

Parties shall determine for itself the following guidelines for the implementation of cooperation under this Memorandum:

- cooperation in the training of highly qualified scientific and pedagogical staff and specialists in the areas of mutual interest;
- the invitation of representatives of the Parties to give lectures, exchange of experience and information on educational and methodical work, as well as curricula and programs;
- joint scientific and technological research with the involvement of professorial staff for the co-management and scientific advice in the writing of master's and doctoral theses;
- joint conferences, seminars, symposia, round tables and days devoted to Parties and other educational initiatives;
- publication of research, teaching and learning materials on the results of joint activities;
- exchange of publications, research, instructional literature, periodicals, information on current events;
- invitation administrative staff to improve the management system and structure with the introduction of modern administrative methods in management;
- support innovative projects;
- education and outreach;
- event management and implementation of projects to promote innovative thinking and entrepreneurship;
- exchange of students, undergraduates, doctoral students and faculty of the Parties;
- adaptation and promotion of effective models and practices of innovation.

Article 5

For the organization and coordination of activities in areas specified in this Memorandum, the preparation of issues of mutual interest and proposals for their implementation, the Parties shall on a regular basis to share information and engage each other to the information and negotiating cooperation with third parties (including foreign).

Article 6

All changes and additions to this Memorandum formalized in writing in the form of protocols, which are becoming an integral part of this Memorandum. All disputes between the parties are resolved by negotiations.

Article 7

This Memorandum does not affect the rights and obligations of the Parties arising from other agreements (contracts), which are part of the participants. This Memorandum is in the nature of the Protocol of Intent and a title document is not.

Article 8

This Memorandum shall enter into force on the date of its signing and shall remain in force until one of the Parties declares its desire to terminate it by written notice to the other Party not later than 1 month prior to the intended date of termination of its validity.

If for any reason this Memorandum shall terminate in accordance with the above procedures, it will not affect the implementation of measures, programs and projects, approved and funded by the Parties prior to its termination.
